NOTE: All surfaces should be clean and dry before attaching brackets.

- 1. Place wheels in straight forward position.
- 2. Using a 18mm wrench remove the stock nut and bolt from bracket A. Retain hardware for later use.
- 3. Using a 18mm wrench remove the nut from bracket B. Retain the stock nut for later use.
- 4. Remove the stock steering stabilizer.
- 5. Using a 13mm wrench loosen the u-bolts holding bracket C. Move the bracket ¾" toward the passengers side. Tighten u-bolts.
- 6. Insert sleeve from kit bag into the rod end of the 721063 cylinder.
- 7. Place rod end on cylinder in bracket A, insert factory bolt and nut.
- 8. Extend stabilizer to bracket B, insert on stud and replace the factory nut.
- 6. Turn wheels fully to the right and left making sure that no interference occurs and that wheel stops are fully contacted.
- 7. Recheck all nuts for tightness before releasing installation.
- 8. Periodically inspect the assembly for tightness.
